

Announcement of the Amsterdam International Go Tournament

May 25th to May 28th 2017

We keep up the tradition to organize the Amsterdam Tournament around Ascension Day. For some years now the tournament is part of the European Grand Prix, organized by the EGF: winners can earn bonus points that will lead to nice rewards later. During the Amsterdam Tournament there will be a professional player present: Catalin Taranu (5P). We are pleased to have him. He will give comments on your games and answers to your many questions about go.

The Amsterdam Tournament consists of following parts:

- If you arrive the day before the main tournament you can join the Blitz tournament (Wednesday)
- The main tournament is spread over four days: from May 25th to 28th May. The format will be 7 games, Japanese rules with 6½ komi, McMahon system, 1½ hour basic time + 1 time 30s of byo-yomi. If you want you can participate in the weekend only (4 games).
- DNM Rapid tournament: Friday Qualifiers (3 rounds, 30min sudden death) and Saturday Finals (Quarter Final, Semi Final, Final).
- A separate event DGT Dubble Digit tournament: a tournament for starters. It is played in parallel to the main tournament on Saturday.

On Saturday evening our chef Roel van Kollum will prepare and serve a barbecue.

We extended the period with 2 weeks in which you can enter the event with a discount. **Up to April 15th you get the early bird entrance fee.**
