9. Official expenses for representative players

1) Accommodation and meals are will be offered by KABA

- Period: from 9th(check-in, dinner) ~ 15th(Check-out, breakfast) of September
- Participants who wish to stay longer than the above period must inform us about your plan(visiting places & purpose), accommodation information, and emergency contact during the extended period.
- If you are a vegetarian or wish to require special diets, please make a detailed description in your registration form.

2) Flight

- KABA will book a round-trip flight ticket (economy class) to/from Incheon International Airport through a travel agent and pay maximum 70% of the full airfare, then players have to pay the remaining amount of the airfare into the travel agent's bank account. Below is a table for the **maximum amount** KABA can pay for each continent.

10. Requests

- 1) Each association can select the representative player according to their rules. Any associations/federations that hold the Korean Ambassador's Cup should choose the winner of the competition as the representative player.
- 2) The representative player must have the nationality of the country he/she represents.
- 3) **If participants need a visa, please check required documents in the Korean embassy and let us know the documents when you submit your registration form.**
- 4) All participants are kindly requested to refrain from wearing T-shirts, jeans, or similar attire during games, opening/awarding&closing ceremony.
- 5) The top 3 players and 1~2 randomly selected player(s) have to accept the anti-doping test.
