Formula

- Double Elimination
- Tournament

Time allowance

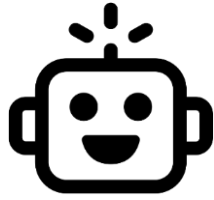
- Even game, a Dum(Komi) of 6.5 points
- 60 mins each, over time: 30 secs * three times

Rule

- KBF standard rules
- Referees will observe all the matches

.2 Cheating



Penalty

- If the use of AI system got caught, that country will not be allowed to participate in future KPMCs

-----• Players must do...

- Videocall by **Skype** during the match
- Play at least five games until the end of the July (www.tygem.com)
- Check network environment before each match (all the results caused by personal environment cannot be helped)
- Know there would be referees observing each match
- Know if a report of cheating appears, three professional referees will judge
- Acknowledge the conclusion that three referees decide unanimously

※ Match schedule is flexible by you, your opposing team, and referee among the period(two days as noted) due to the time difference. The local committee will take care of this procedure.

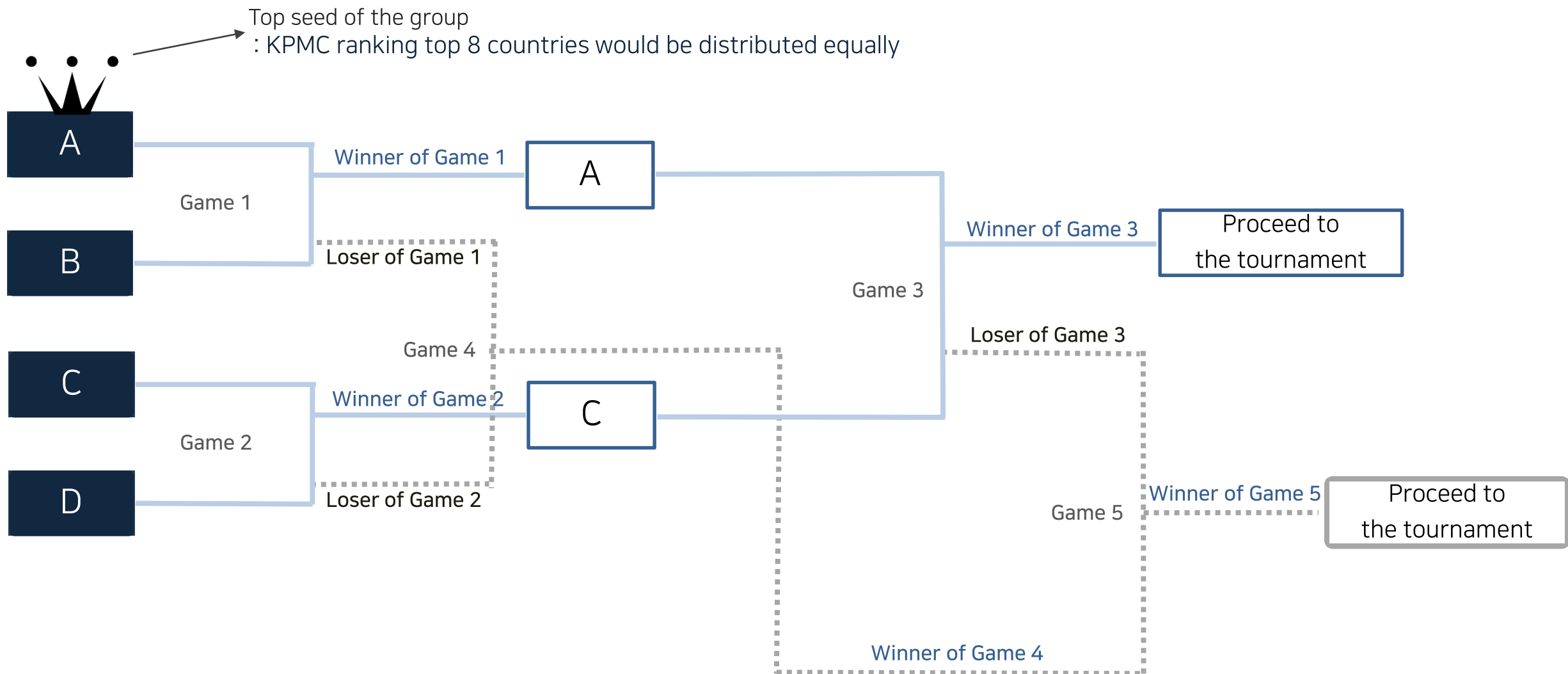

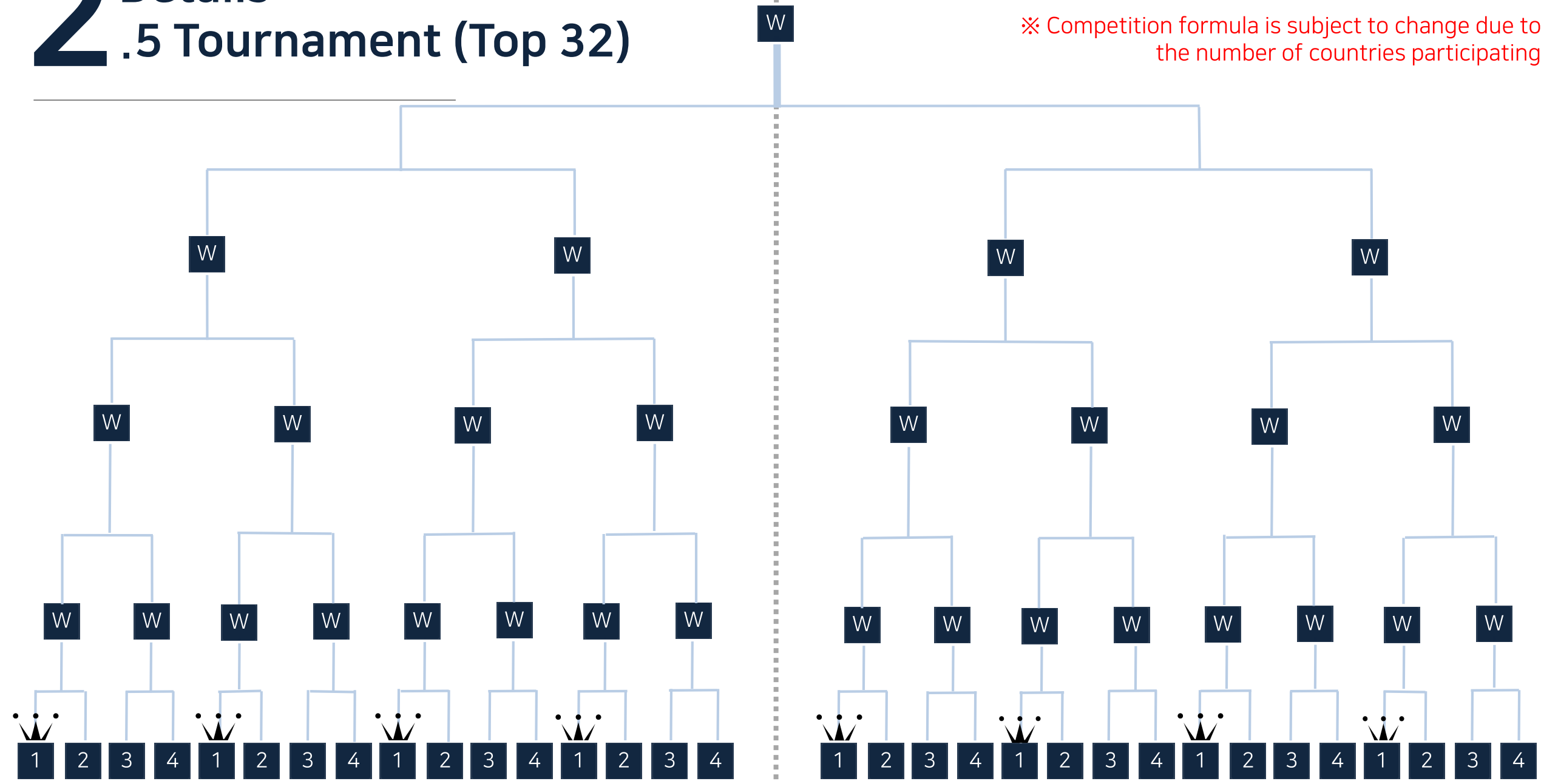

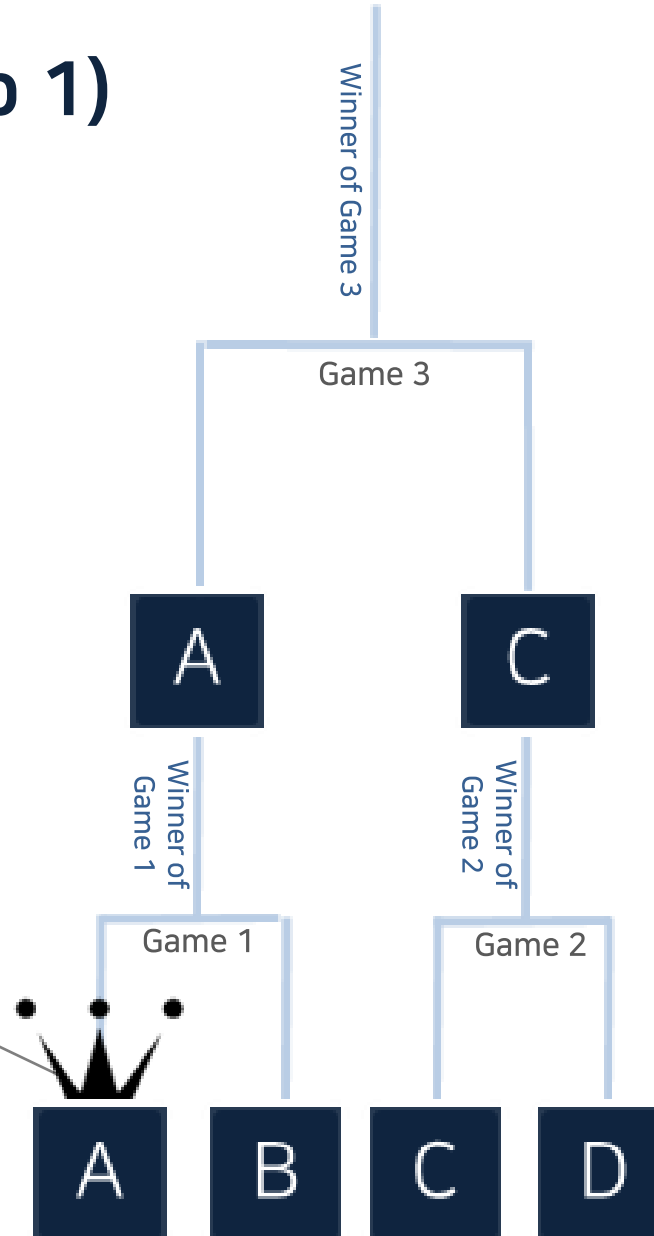
