

We are sincerely looking forward to welcoming you in Korea!





- 1) One (1) player is allowed to participate from each country/territories.
- 2) Each Association is allowed to select the representative player according to their rules. Any Associations/Federations that hold the Korean Ambassador's Cup shall choose the winner of the competition as the representative player.
- 3) The representative player must have the nationality of the country he/she represents.

6. Official Expenses

1) Accommodation and Meals

- **All meals and accommodation fee** will be provided by Korea Baduk Federation (KBF).

(* Meals will be offered from check-in time of the arrival day to check-out time of the departure day)

Date	Sept 24 (after check-in, dinner) - Sept 30 (before check-out, breakfast)
Note	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -One (1) participant may use one (1) room. -If you want to share the room with family, friends, etc., please let us know it(number of members, etc.) in advance. -Participants who wish to stay longer than the above period must inform KBF of the itinerary (including visiting places & purpose), accommodation information, an emergency contact, etc., during the extended period. -If you are a vegetarian or wish to require a special diet, please make a detailed description in your registration form.

2) Flight

- KBF will book a round-trip flight ticket (economy class) to/from Incheon International Airport. According to the itinerary of the participants, KBF will pay **up to 50%(with limited amount)** of the total air fare for the representative players, and the participant must pay **the remaining balance directly to the travel agency's bank account.**

In case of the officials of international Baduk Association including AGF(Asian Go Federation), airfare, all accommodation and meals during the competition will be provided.

- Below is the **cost table** showing **the maximum amount KBF can pay** for each player by continents.

Continent	Asia	Europe/Africa/Oceania/North America	Middle&South America
About Amount	About 400,000 KRW (≒ 304 USD)	About 800,000 KRW (≒ 609 USD)	About 1,800,000 KRW (≒ 1,370 USD)

For instance)

- 1) Flight airfare \$500 for Asian country -> \$250 supported by KBF (50% of the airfare)
- 2) Flight airfare \$1000 for Asian country -> \$304 supported by KBF (limited amount of \$381)

***Please assure that the above amount is approximately calculated and currently undecided**

7. Registration

- 2) Identification photo in jpg/jpeg (coloured, size 3x4cm)
- 3) Copy of passport (page with personal details and signature is necessary)

*An individual participation fee for any person accompanying the representative players is **USD 700**, which would be necessary to provide accommodation, meals, transportation, and sightseeing same as players during the 17th KPMC.

*The participation fee can be discounted up to **USD 200** only if the person accompanying the player **shares the room** which the player uses.

Regardless of sharing one room with guests, only the 'one' guest who shares the room provided to players could get the discount.

For instance)

- 1) 1 guest sharing player's room -> \$500 participation fee
- 2) 3 guest: 1 sharing player's room and 2 stays in another room -> \$500 fee for the one who shares the room with a player and \$700 fee for the rest two who stay in another room
- 3) 3 guest: 1 sharing player's room and 2 stays in other rooms -> \$500 fee for the one who shares the room with a player and \$700 fee for the rest two who stay in other rooms

***Please assure that the fee amount is approximately calculated and subject to change.**

8. Requests

- If a player needs a Korean Visa, please check required documents with the Korean Embassy, and let us know if there is any document that needs to be prepared by the KBF when submitting the Visa application.

- All players shall not wear t-shirts, jeans or similar attire during the opening ceremonies
