

There were 11 cancels including some no-shows in last KPMC, which brought serious waste of budget and about 20% loss of the budget for this KPMC eventually.

KBF has received serious feedback about this issue from the high authority.

In the last three years, there has been an average of 7.3 cancellations including no-shows even since the cancellation deadline.

As such a waste of budget has resulted in the reduction of supports from the government, KBF decides to react stronger.

Also, KPMC has received claims from a few participants or staffs about the improper or impolite behavior of few participants.

Through an internal system to evaluate such data, KBF will impose the penalty to those who have brought damage to KPMC operation.

The announcement will be forwarded individually to the organization in order to avoid any official shame.

It is the goal to reduce risks and maximize the budget efficiency for most participants even though the total participants might decrease.
